MAJORS, MINORS, AND CONCENTRATIONS

Students are required to declare a major during their fourth semester at the College. Students are not required to have a minor or a concentration, and they may pursue as many of them as is consistent with completing one major, fulfilling distributional requirements, and earning at least 32 credits overall within the eight semesters they are allotted for the completion of their degrees. Numbers in the chart below indicate the amount of required credits for each program.
